## **NEEM**

**Synonyms:-**Margosa, Nim.

### **Biological Source**

It consists of leaves and other aerial parts of *Azadirachta indica*, A. Juss, Syn: *Melia Azadirachta*. Linn belongs to family Meliaceae.

### **Geographical Source**

It is indigenous and widely grown in India. It grows in various tropical and subtropical Regions of the world.

### **General Description:**

The plant is propagated by seeds. Neem grows in tropical, as well as, arid regions. It may be considered as undemanding plant. It grows in nutrient deficient soils. It survives high temperatures, little rainfall and prolonged periods of drought. It grows well at pH 5 and in moist stony, clayey or shallow soil. The roots can extract nutrients from sandy or highly leached soil. The plant bears fruits after 5 years and between May to August. The Neem tree grows about 8 metres in height yielding about 350 kg foliage in dried form and 35 – 55 kg fruits annually.

### **Organoleptic Characters:**

**Leaves:** Imparipinnate 20-37 cm in length. Leaflets are opposite or alternate, obliquely falcate lanceolate, serrate, dark green to greenish yellow in colour and

bitter in Taste.

**Flowers:** White scented 5 mm long pentamers, staminal tube dentate, anthers Inserted inside.

**Fruits:** Drupe 1.2 to 1.8 cm long, oblong, 1 seeded smooth greenish yellow in Colour. Intensively bitter in Taste.

**Bark:** Rough, greyish to brownish in colour, channelled in shape, about 10 mm in Thickness with scaly to fissured surface. Internally yellowish in colour laminated and Fibrous.

### **Chemical Constituents**

The different parts of Neem tree contain different constituents. Among them, the active Ingredients are azadirachtin, salannin and meliantriol. The neem leaves contain Nimbosterol and quercetin. The seeds contain azadirachtin, salanin, meliantrol and Meliacin. The trunk bark contains nimbin, nimbinin, nimbidin, nimbosterol and a bitter Principle called margosine. Neem oil is expressed from seeds and it contains chiefly Glycerides of oleic (50 %) and stearic (20 %) acids.

### **Uses**

He neem leaves and the neem oil are used mainly as antiseptics and insecticides.

Neem oil, nimbin and nimbidin are active against various fungi.

The anti-insect principles have been commercialized in the form of vapaside and margosides.

The drug is also Attributed antifertility and anti-viral properties, and is being screened for efficacy in Treatment of AIDS.



## Turmeric

**Synonyms:** Indian saffron, Haldi, Haridra

**Biological Source:**

Turmeric consists of dried, as well as, fresh rhizomes of plant known as *Curcuma Longa* Linn,- (*C. domestica*), belonging to family Zingiberaceae. It contains not less than 1.5 % of curcumin.

**Geographical Source:**

It is found throughout the tropical countries and especially, cultivated in West Pakistan, India, Malaysia and China. In India, it is largely cultivated in Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal, U.P. and Punjab.

**Organoleptic Properties:**

**Colour:**

**External** - yellowish to yellowish-brown. **Internal**- yellowish-orange to orange.

**Odour:** Characteristic.

**Taste:** Slightly bitter.

**Size:** 2 to 5 cm in length and 1 to 2 cm in thickness. Root scars and annulations are present.



**Shape:** Round turmeric rhizomes are ovate or oblong, while the long turmeric Rhizomes are cylindrical and short branched. The fracture of rhizome is horny.

**Chemical Constituents:**

Turmeric contains about 5% of volatile oil, resin, abundant zingiberaceous starch grains and yellow coloring substance known as curcuminoids. The chief constituents are curcumin, termerone, zingiberine, borneol, caprylic acid etc.

**Uses:-**

Turmeric is used as antiseptic.

Turmeric is used as expectorant a condiments or spice.

Turmeric is used as colouring agent, especially for cream and ointment.

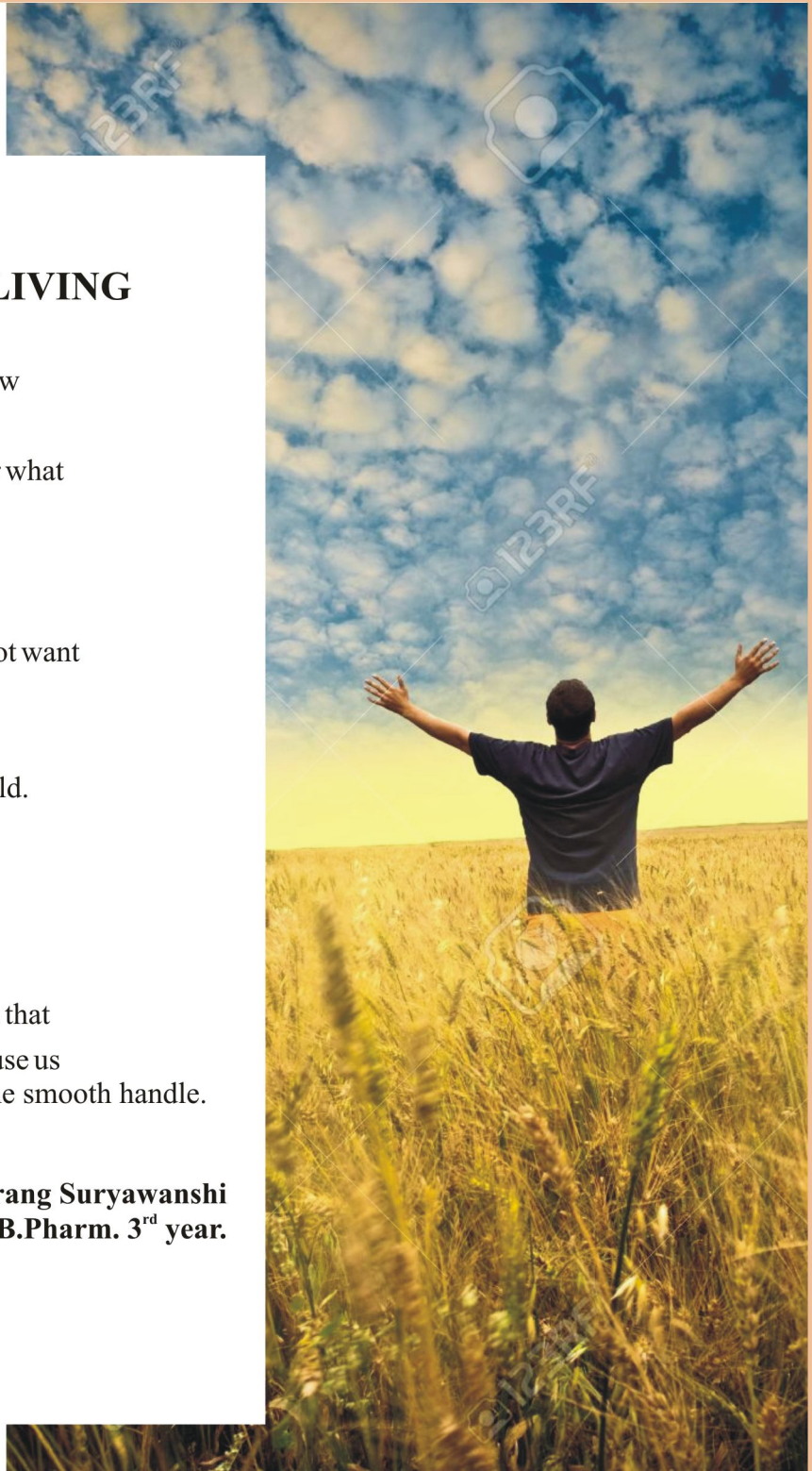

## ANTI-TUSSIVES- TULSI



Synonyms: Sacred basil, Holy basil

Biological Source: Tulsi consists of fresh and dried leaves of *Ocimum sanctum* Linn.

Family: Labiatae

### **Organoleptic Properties:**

It is much branched small herb about 30 to 75 cm in height. All parts of tulsi are used in medicine, especially fresh and dried leaves. The leaves are oblong, acute with entire or serrate margin, pubescent on both sides and minutely gland-dotted. The leaves are green in

colour with aromatic flavour and slightly pungent taste.

### **Chemical Constituents:**

Tulsi leaves are found to contain bright, yellow coloured and pleasant volatile oil from 0.1 to 0.9%. The oil content of the drug varies depending upon the type, place of cultivation and season of its collection. The oil is collected by steam distillation method from leaves and flowering tops. Chemically, it contains approximately 70% eugenol, carvacrol (3%) and eugenol-methyl-ether (20%). It also contains caryophyllin. Seeds contain fixed oil with good drying properties. The plant is also reported to contain traces of alkaloids, saponin, tannin, an appreciable amount of vitamin C, and traces of maleic, citric and tartaric acid.

### **Uses:**

The fresh leaves, its juice and volatile oil are used for various purposes. The oil is Antibacterial and insecticidal. The leaves are used as stimulant.

Uses: The leaves, rhizome and seeds have been used in Ayurveda for diarrhea, cholera and fever.



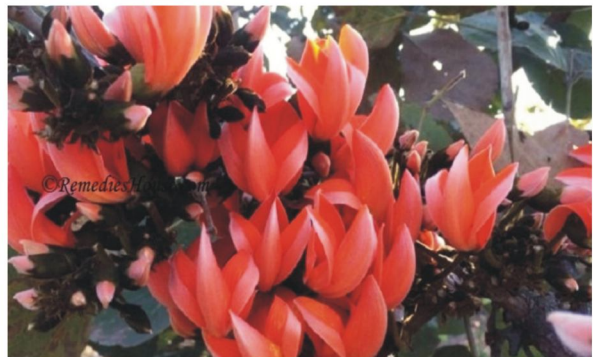
### **Brahma Kamal (*Saussurea obvallata*)**

### **Palash (*Butea monosperma*)**

Palash also known as flame of the forest bloom during the early summer in most of the parts of the Indian Subcontinent.

Uses: The [flowers of Palash](#) are used to prepare color for Holi festival which antimicrobial activity and the bark to treat external wounds, diarrhea and urinary disorders.



### **Kewda (Pandanus)**

Kewra is actually not a flower but an extract distilled from the flower Screwpine tree or Pandanus.

Uses: Oil is used in traditional Indian perfumery. The oil extracted from male [kewra flowers](#) is used in Ayurveda to treat arthritis.



### **Gudhal (Hibiscus rosa sinensis)**

There are red, orange pink, yellow and white varieties of Hibiscus flowers available in India.

Uses: Leaves and flowers are extensively used in Ayurveda to lower blood pressure and [hibiscus tea](#) made from dried flowers is one of the most popular drinks, consumed both hot

and cold

### **Aparajita (Clitoria ternatea)**

The [butterfly pea](#) is flowering vine and native to tropical India.

Uses: it is used in traditional Ayurveda for enhancing memory and sedative properties. The blue flower is used as a natural food colouring and also for flower tea mixed with honey



### **Ashoka (Saraca asoca)**

Ashoka tree is one of the most important trees of the Indian subcontinent, considered sacred and valued for its flowers.

Uses: [Ashoka flowers](#), leaves and bark are used in abdominal pain, heart and uterine disorders.



### **Burans (Rhododendron arboretum)**

The edible flower used to make squash called burans in Uttarakhand and also for herbal tea for treating body inflammation. Rhododendron arboreum is state flower of Himachal Pradesh and Nagaland.

**Generic Market exporting:** Just like any other industry, the pharmaceutical industry is also a sales-driven industry. With the help of AI technology, companies can gather information regarding targeting audiences and create unique marketing strategies for them. This way they can understand the needs of the market and can convert most leads into revenues. AI can help in protecting the success or failure rate of the marketing strategy.

**Effect of External Market:** More than 50% of [Pharmaceutical Ingredients](#) are dependent on other countries such as China. Slight changes in policies can bring a big difference in the production of medicines and equipment (e.g., to fulfil domestic consumption, America delays the export of raw material for manufacturing Covid-19 vaccines which creates an extra burden on manufacturers in India). For a developing country, our government needs to create an environment for the healthcare start-up, so that companies and patients can co-exist without burdening each other.

### **Conclusion:**

Due to growth in the Pharma industry in India, both directly and indirectly about 2.7 million jobs have been created for the citizens. Government needs to make India a life sciences innovation hub to promote innovation by creating a research ecosystem and expanding and up skill the talent pool to handle complex technologies with advanced resources.

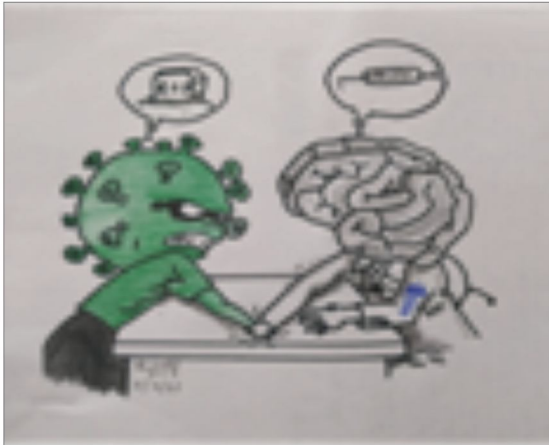

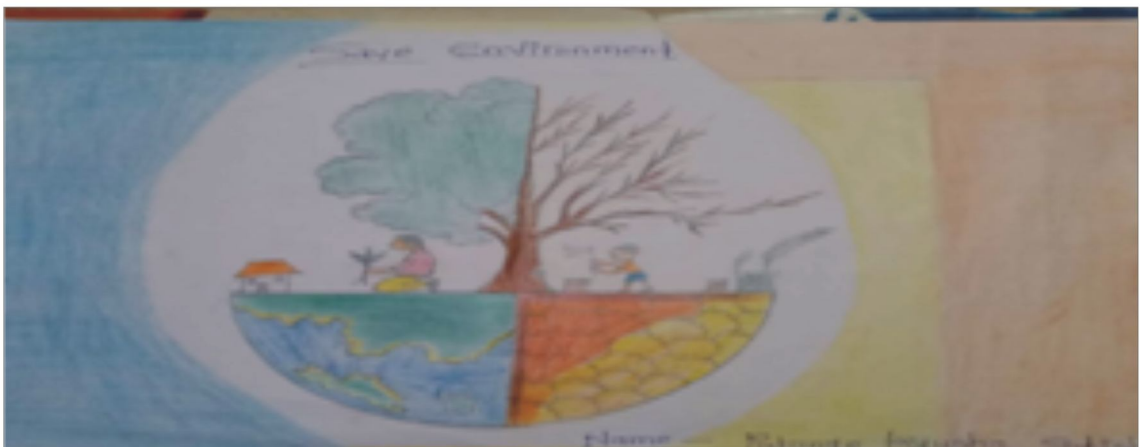
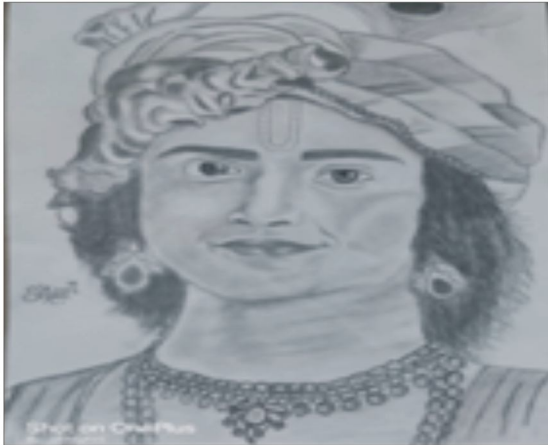


as engineering, medicine, accountancy, nursing, architecture and law.

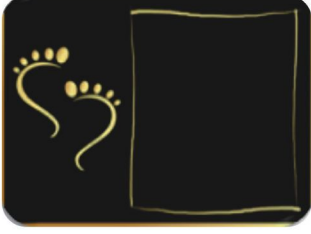

अशांत मन को शांत करता है

इसे सुबह के समय करना चाहिए। यह आवश्यक है कि आप खाली पेट रहे। जमीन पर मैट बिछाकर बैठ जायें। ध्यान हमेशा शांत स्थान पर करना चाहिए। अपनी दोनों आंखें बंद करें। ध्यान करते समय सीधा बैठना चाहिये। अपनी रीढ़ की हड्डी को सीधा रखें। कंधे और गर्दन को विश्राम दें। इसे करने से पहले थोड़ा वार्मअप (कसरत) करें।

उसके बाद अपनी दोनों

आंखों को बंद करे और ध्यान लगायें। ध्यान करते समय लंबी और गहरी सांस लेनी चाहिए। सांस को स्थिर रखें। आपका मन शांत हो जाएगा। दोनों आँखे बंद कर अपने चेहरे पर एक मुस्कान रखें। ध्यान करने के बाद अपनी आंखें धीरे धीरे खोलें।

निष्कर्ष

अंत में हम यही कहेंगे ध्यान या मेडिटेशन दिमाग के हर परत को खोल सा देता है। ध्यान से शांति की प्राप्ति होती है जीवन के हर क्षेत्र में सफलता मिलती है। आज ही ध्यान करना शुरू करें और एक सुंदर जीवन का लाभ उठायें।

## ऑनलाईन+ऑफलाईन= उद्याचे शिक्षण

ऑनलाईन आणि ऑफलाईन यांचे सुयोग्य मिश्रण असलेली 'संमिश्र शिक्षण पद्धत' (Blended Learning) ही भविष्यातील महत्वाची शिक्षण पद्धत ठरेल, असे आजचे चित्र आहे. सध्या कोरोनाच्या जागतिक संकटामुळे शाळा बंद आहेत. शाळा सुरु करण्याजोगी परिस्थिती कधी निर्माण होईल, हे आज सांगता येणे कठीण आहे. शाळा सुरु झाल्याच तरी, सामाजिक अंतराचे नियम काय असतील आणि ते पाळून शाळा पूर्ववत चालवता येतील का, हेही सांगता येणे कठीण आहे. सरकारने शाळा 'ऑनलाईन' सुरु करायला परवानगी दिली आहे. अनेक शाळांनी कोणत्या ना कोणत्या पद्धतीचे, ऑनलाईन उपक्रम सुरु देखील केले आहेत. पण, या साऱ्याची पुढील दिशा काय असेल? याचा विचार गांभीर्याने करायला हवा. आपल्याकडे मोबाईल, लॅपटॉप अशी उपकरणे वापरून, आपण अनेक गोष्टी करतो. पण या माध्यमांचा वापर करून शाळा किंवा कोणत्याही प्रकारचे शैक्षणिक उपक्रम चालवणे, हे आपल्यासाठी पूर्णपणे नवीन आहे. कोरोनामुळे लादल्या गेलेल्या सक्तीच्या सुटीमुळे हे ऑनलाईन माध्यम एकाएकीच आपल्या गळ्यात पडले. पण या ऑनलाईन शिक्षणाची आजची परिस्थिती काय आहे? त्यासाठी कोणते पर्याय उपलब्ध आहेत? ते आज कोणत्या प्रकारे वापरले जात आहेत? या सगळ्याचे भविष्य काय असेल? या प्रश्नांचा उहापोह करताना, सर्वात महत्वाचे म्हणजे या साऱ्यातून आपल्याला नक्की काय साध्य करायचे आहे? ते समजून घ्यायला हवे.

### शिक्षणाचे घटक

साधारणतः शिक्षणाचे तीन प्रमुख घटक असतात. अध्यापन (teaching), अध्ययन (learning) आणि मूल्यमापन (evaluation) या तीन घटकांसाठी शिक्षणप्रक्रिया राबविली जाते. आता हे तीनही घटक या नव्या ऑनलाईन पद्धतीत कसे आकार घेतील ते पाहूया. ऑनलाईन शिक्षणाचा विचार करताना, हे तीनही घटक ऑनलाईन माध्यमांमधून पूर्ण करता येतील अशी व्यवस्था किंवा प्रणाली वापरायला हवी. सध्याची परिस्थिती बघता बहुसंख्य शाळा अथवा प्रशिक्षक फक्त 'अध्यापन' ऑनलाईन करण्यावर भर देत आहेत, असे दिसत आहे. झूम किंवा गूगल

मीट सारखे तंत्रज्ञान वापरून शिक्षक आणि विद्यार्थ्यांचा व्हिडियो कॉल सेटअप करणे आणि त्यात शिक्षकांनी वर्गात बोलतात, त्याप्रमाणे बोलून शिकवणे अशी सध्याच्या बहुसंख्य ऑनलाईन वर्गांची परिस्थिती दिसत आहे. काही कल्पक शिक्षक आपल्या लेक्चरचे पॉवरपॉइंट प्रेझेंटेशन करून, ते व्हिडियो कॉलवर दाखवतात आणि विषय समजावून सांगतात. भविष्यात या नव्या ऑनलाईन शिक्षण पद्धतीत प्रत्येकासाठी व्यक्तिगत शिक्षणाचे नियोजन (लर्निंग प्लॅन), शिक्षणाचा मार्ग (लर्निंग पाथ) असू शकतात. वयानुसार आणि व्यक्तिगत क्षमतेनुसार त्या नियोजनामध्ये लवचिकता येऊ शकते. म्हणजे दहा वर्षांचे एक मूल त्याच्या नैसर्गिक क्षमतेनुसार, चौथीचे तर दुसरे मूल त्याच्या क्षमतेनुसार सातवी-आठवीचे

गणित शिकू शकते. हे आज घडत नाही, पण उद्या कदाचित असे घडू शकेल. प्रत्येकजण आपापल्या क्षमतेनुसार आणि आवडीनिवडीनुसार आपल्या शिक्षणाचा मार्ग निवडू शकेल.

शाळांमध्ये मुले पारंपारिक शिक्षणासोबत सामाजिक वर्तन (सोशल स्किल्स) सुद्धा शिकत असतात. कोणत्याही व्यक्तीच्या जडणघडणीमध्ये तो जिथे शिकतो तिथल्या वातावरणाचा, संगतीचा आणि सोशल स्किल्सचा अत्यंत महत्वाचा वाटा असतो. पूर्णपणे ऑनलाईन असलेल्या शिक्षण पद्धतीमध्ये मुलांनी आपल्या समवयीन मुलांमध्ये गटाने एकत्र रहाणे, एकमेकांशी मैत्री करणे, मैदानात एकत्र खेळणे, दंगामस्ती करणे इत्यादी गोष्टी घडत नाहीत. या सगळ्यातून आपोआप शिकले जाणारे सामाजिक वर्तनाचे नियम, सामाजिक शिस्त आणि संबंधित सोशल स्किल्स ही ऑनलाईन शिक्षणातून देता येत नाहीत. ऑनलाईन शिक्षणाची ही सगळ्यांत मोठी मर्यादा आहे. याचबरोबर, ऑनलाईन शिक्षणासाठी शिक्षक आणि विद्यार्थी दोघांकडेही पुरेशा क्षमतेची तांत्रिक उपकरणे (स्मार्टफोन्स, टॅब्लेट्स, लॅपटॉप्स इत्यादी) आणि पुरेशी बँडविडथ असलेले आणि सतत सुरु



असलेले हाय स्पीड इंटरनेट असणे गरजेचे असते. यातली पुरेशा क्षमतेची तांत्रिक उपकरणे सर्व विद्यार्थी आणि शिक्षकांकडे असतातच, त्यांना ती परवडतातच असे नाही. ग्रामीण भाग, शहरी कनिष्ठ आणि निम्नमध्यमवर्ग सोडा, अगदी मध्यमवर्ग आणि उच्च मध्यमवर्गातही मुलांना त्यांच्या मालकीचा स्मार्टफोन किंवा लॅपटॉप देणे सगळ्यांनाच शक्य नसते.

ऑनलाईन शिक्षण व्यवस्था ही काळाची गरज आहे. अत्यंत कमी खर्चात प्रत्येक विद्यार्थ्यांपर्यंत पोहोचू शकेल, आणि प्रत्येकाला आपापल्या आवड आणि क्षमतेनुसार घेता येईल असे शिक्षण खरोखर महत्वाचे आहे. मात्र, ऑनलाईन शिक्षणाच्या काही महत्वाच्या मर्यादांमुळे पारंपारिक शालेय शिक्षण आणि शाळांना तो संपूर्ण पर्याय ठरेलच असे नाही. संमिश्र शिक्षण पद्धत (Blended Learning) ही भविष्यातली महत्वाची शिक्षण पद्धत असेल. जे विषय ऑनलाईन शिकता येणे शक्य आहे त्यांचे अध्यापन-अध्ययन ऑनलाईन होणे. जे विषय प्रत्यक्ष एकत्र येऊनच शिकावे लागतात त्यासाठी शाळांसारख्या संस्थांमध्ये एकत्र येणे, अशा दोन्ही पद्धतींचा वापर येणाऱ्या काळात करावा लागेल. त्याचबरोबर मूल्यमापनाच्या पद्धतींमध्ये प्रमाणीकरण करून त्या ऑनलाईन पद्धतीने राबवल्या तर देशातल्या कोणालाही कुठूनही हव्या त्या अभ्यासक्रमाची परीक्षा देता येणे शक्य होईल. या सर्व एखाद दुसऱ्या वर्षात घडणाऱ्या गोष्टी नाहीत. वर्षानुवर्षे अनेक सरकारी आणि खासगी संस्थांनी एकमेकांशी समन्वय साधत प्रयत्न केले तर संपूर्णपणे आधुनिक आणि सर्वाना उपलब्ध अशी नवी शिक्षण व्यवस्था आपण उभी करू शकू.

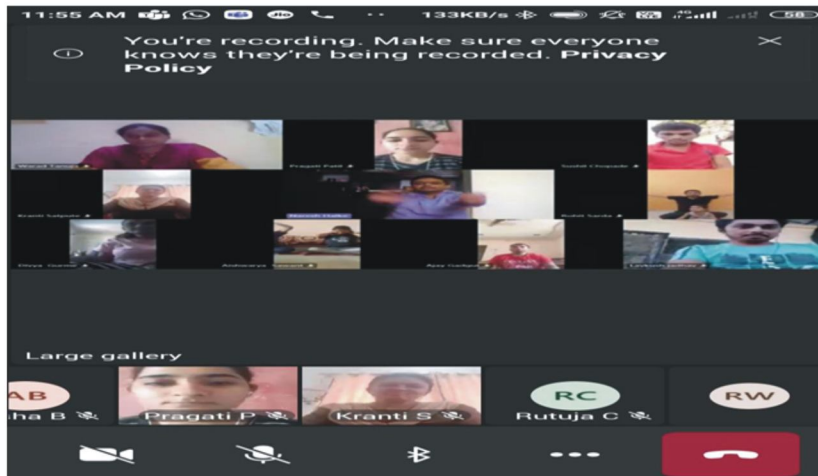

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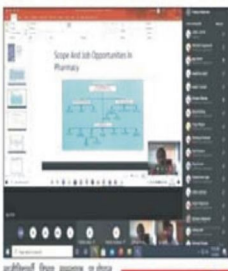
