

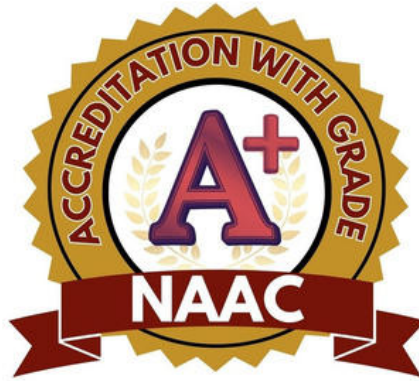

PHARMACIST'S OATH

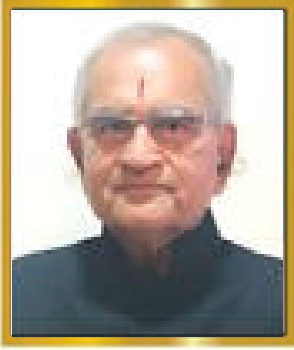
- I swear by the code of Ethics of Pharmacy Council of India in relation to the community and shall act as an integral part of health care team.

- Should I trespass and violate this oath may the reverse be my lot!



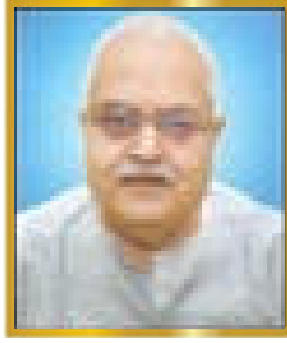
